Cases

Johnson v. HCR ManorCare, Inc.

Johnson v. HCR ManorCare, Inc. – The Bailey & Glasser appellate team supported the trial team with strategic planning, error preservation, and a keen eye for discrepancies in testimony in a trial that resulted in a full verdict in favor of the client, HCR ManorCare, Inc.

Allen v. GreatBanc

Allen v. GreatBanc – Bailey & Glasser won reversal in the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Seventh Circuit of the district court's order dismissing an ERISA action involving breaches of fiduciary duty and prohibited transactions in connection with an employee stock ownership plan

Crawford v. Geiger

Crawford v. Geiger – Working with the William and Mary Law School Appellate & Supreme Court Clinic, Bailey & Glasser obtained affirmance of a denial of qualified immunity in a Section 1983 unlawful arrest case in the United States Court of Appeals for the Sixth Circuit.

Sperrazza v. United States

Sperrazza v. United States – Bailey & Glasser filed a petition for a writ of certiorari on criminal structuring.

Charron v. Sallyport Global Holdings, Inc.

Charron v. Sallyport Global Holdings – Bailey & Glasser obtained affirmance in the United States Court of Appeals for the Second Circuit of a \$20 million judgment in a commercial dispute regarding sale of a government contracting company.
