All of the 20 statements below are based on my personal knowledge. 21 1. I am currently enrolled at California State University, Fresno ("Fresno State"). I am a 22 freshman majoring in Pre-Veterinary Medicine. I expect to graduate in 2024. 23 2. I am a member of the varsity women's lacrosse team at Fresno State and I have three years 24 of athletic eligibility left. 25 I am a named plaintiff in this action. - 4. I am personally devastated by the prospect that women's lacrosse is being eliminated as a varsity sport at Fresno State.
- 5. I grew up outside of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, and lacrosse was very popular in my community. I have been playing since the fifth grade. My grade school started a lacrosse team, and the coach invited me to try it after she saw me play basketball. Once the team started, I fell in love with the sport.
- 6. The following year, I started playing on a travel team and continued improving. I continued playing both lacrosse and basketball until eighth grade, when the year-round stress on my body and my academics forced me to choose between the two sports.
- 7. I worked hard and excelled at lacrosse throughout high school. During the college admissions process, my priority was to find a school where I could play lacrosse and that also offered my chosen major, Pre-Veterinary Medicine.
- 8. During my junior year of high school, I committed to play NCAA Division I lacrosse at Saint Francis University in Pennsylvania. However, the following summer, the Saint Francis coaching staff disbanded. One of those staff members, Coach Kara Concheck, was going to take a position at Fresno State as assistant coach, and she invited me to visit the school.
- 9. When I visited Fresno, I fell in love with the school and the team, and knew it was the right place for me because I would be able to play lacrosse all four years and pursue my Pre-Veterinary major.
- 10. This school year, before I had even had a chance to play a season, Fresno State announced that it had decided to eliminate women's lacrosse. While this spring season has not yet been cancelled, this announcement was especially devastating to me because I came to Fresno State with the expectation that I would be able to play four years of lacrosse.
- 11. If our team is not preserved, I will have to transfer schools if I wish to play lacrosse. I feel deceived by Fresno State.
- 12. Coming to Fresno State from the East Coast was a major adjustment for me. I uprooted my life and moved across the country and took the initiative to become happy and settled in this community. I immediately bonded with my teammates and made great friends.

- 13. Now, if I wish to continue playing lacrosse, I will lose these close relationships and have to start over again at a new school among teams and friends that are already integrated. I dread the prospect of having to find a new school with my major and go through the adjustments of moving and making friends all over again.
- 14. The situation has been stressful and frustrating for me. It feels as though the years of hard work and commitment I put into my sport to reach this level were all for nothing.
- 15. I hope that the Court will correct the harm Fresno State has caused to me and my teammates and prevent future harm by preserving the women's lacrosse team.
