Lori Bullock is committed advocate for justice who handles cases across several litigation areas, including labor and employment on behalf of employees, sexual harassment, discrimination, education law, and civil rights.

But it's her work successfully representing student-athletes who've faced discrimination that's attracted national media attention. Working with Bailey Glasser's Title IX team, Lori has won a series of high-profile settlements for female student-athletes at eight U.S. colleges and universities to date. Title IX is the federal civil rights law that prohibits sex discrimination at educational institutions receiving federal funds.

A partner in Bailey Glasser's new Des Moines office, Lori is part of the firm's expanding Labor & Employment practice group. She's a member of the National Employment Lawyers Association, Iowa NELA, Iowa State Bar Association, the Polk County Women Attorneys Association, and C. Edwin Moore Inn of Court.

When she's not protecting student-athletes' rights, Lori enjoys exposing her children to new parts of the world through travel. Lori also enjoys singing and playing board games with friends.
