It had to have been one of the most iconic images from this summer's devastating floods in West Virginia: A house fully engulfed in flames floating down Howard's Creek in White Sulphur Springs.

Mark Adwell, the owner of that house, was having trouble getting paid the \$60,000 owed him by his flood insurance policy.
